

VISITING REGULATIONS OF THE SILESIAN CULTURE CENTRE IN NAKŁO ŚLĄSKIE

1. The exhibitions of the Silesian Culture Centre in Nakło Śląskie (hereinafter referred to as the Centre) can be visited individually or in organised groups.
2. An organised group visiting the exhibition of the Centre with a guide cannot consist of more than 35 people.
3. The tour route may be changed due to conservation and organizational reasons.
4. Priority admission to the Centre is granted to pre-registered groups. The Centre has the right to refuse entry to non-registered groups.
5. When schoolchildren under 18 years of age enter the Centre, they are supervised by their guardians (teachers).
6. Visits to the Centre in organised groups with a guide are possible after prior telephone, postal or electronic reservation (Silesian Culture Centre; 42-620 Nakło Śląskie, 1 Parkowa St., phone - 32 441 60 28, e-mail - biuro.cekus@gmail.com). Reservations should be made at least 7 days before the planned visit.
7. The entrance tickets are purchased in the Ticket Office.
8. The payment currency is PLN.
9. The ticket entitles to a single entry to the Centre's exhibition area. Ticket Inspector may refuse entry to the Centre if a person uses an invalid ticket.
10. Information about the current opening hours of the Centre is available on the website www.cekus.pl, on the door at the main entrance and at phone number 32 441 60 28.
11. The list of entrance and sightseeing fees is available at the Ticket Office and on the website www.cekus.pl.
12. In case of cancellation of a booked visit to the exhibition of the Silesian Culture Centre, a notice of cancellation should be submitted in one of the following ways:

13. On the premises of the Centre, it is necessary to behave in a respectful manner, not violating the rules of good conduct.
14. It is not allowed to enter the Centre by people:
 - a) under the influence of alcohol, intoxicants, psychotropic drugs or other substances having a similar effect,

- b) in possession of weapons or other objects dangerous to life or health, with the exception of people performing their duties as police officers in the course of duty;
- c) behaving aggressively, provocatively or in any other manner that poses a threat to the safety of the collections, disturbs other visitors or violates generally accepted standards of behaviour in public places,
- d) inappropriately dressed,
- e) not adhering to the provisions of these Regulations.
